**Waiver of Liability and Emergency Medical Care Authorization**

This waiver of Liability and Emergency Medical Care Authorization is made on behalf of the Participant named below ("Participant") so that East Kentucky Miners will allow Participant to participate in the following activity:

**CAMP:** East Kentucky Miners Free Agent Camp

**LOCATION:** East Kentucky Expo Center

**DATE:** Sept. 6

Participant desires to participate in the camp, which is strictly voluntary. In consideration of East Kentucky Miners allowing Participant to participate in the Camp, and other good and valuable consideration, Participant now makes the Agreement in favor of East Kentucky Miners fully intending for Participant to be legally bound by the terms of the Agreement.

Participant accepts and assumes all responsibility for any risk of personal injury that may occur to Participant while participating in the Camp. Participant waives and releases any claim or right of action which Participant may have, now or in the future, against East Kentucky Miners, its directors, officers, agents, and employees, arising out of Participant's participation in the Camp. Participant agrees to indemnify East Kentucky Miners, its directors, officers, agents, and employees, and to hold them harmless against and from any and all liabilities, damages, claims, suits, judgements and associated costs and expenses (including, without limitation, reasonable attorney's fees) arising in connection with Participant's participation in the Camp. This agreement applies to claims of any nature arising from Participant's participation in the Camp except for intentional misconduct or gross negligence.

Participating in the Camp involves strenuous physical activity and risks of possible injury or death to Participant. Some of these risks are foreseeable and others may be unknown or unanticipated. Participant represents that Participant has no physical, mental, or emotional condition which would interfere with Participant's ability to participate in the Camp or which would endanger the health or safety of Participant or any other person, except as indicated by Participant in writing attached to this document.

If Participant needs emergency medical care, Participant authorizes East Kentucky Miners, its employees, and agents to authorize medical care and to make medical decisions on Participant's behalf. Participant agrees to pay for such medical care and to release and indemnify East Kentucky Miners, its employees, and agents from any costs, expense or liability associated with making emergency medical decisions for Participant or providing Participant medical care.

If East Kentucky Miners or anyone acting on its behalf incurs attorney's fees or other costs to enforce this Agreement, Participant agrees to indemnify and hold them harmless for all such fees and costs. This agreement shall be interpreted under the law of Kentucky. Any legal action resulting from Participant's participation in the Camp shall be brought only in the county in which the camp is held. Participant agrees that this agreement is binding on Participant, Participant's Spouse, heirs, assigns, estate, and personal representatives.

**This agreement is a contract with legal consequences. Participant acknowledges that if Participant suffers an injury while participating in the Camp, Participant may be found by a court of law to have waived any rights to maintain a lawsuit against East Kentucky Miners. Participant has had the opportunity to read this document, understands it, and agrees to be bound by its terms.**
